Housing

- There are 46 self contained units to rent. Of these, 10 are bedsits, 35 are one-bedroomed flats (2 of which are designated disabled units) and 1 is a two-bedroomed flat.
- All units have self contained bathroom/shower room.
- Each kitchen is supplied with a range of units. You will need to provide other kitchen items.
- Units are unfurnished and you will need to provide your own carpets, curtains and furniture.
- There is a door entry system and community alarm.
- All units are fitted with an Alarm System.
- All units are fitted with smoke detectors.
- There is lift access to part of the building
- The building is wheelchair accessible.
- Pets are not allowed.

Support and care

Support is provided by a Scheme Manager who is available Monday to Friday in the daytime. An office based Sheltered Housing Officer is available Monday – Friday, 9.00am – 5.00pm.

If you have a problem when no staff are available you can contact the Community Alarm Service.

If necessary, our Out of Hours Officer may attend.

Other facilities

Communal Facilities include a kitchen, lounge, toilet, laundry room, garden and guest room.
